




Dr. Hiram Useless arrives at work to find that the bank has closed his lab and factory.




But I'm the World's #1 supplier

I dreamed of making bike parts...






I was the first person to design an eHuman, to divest the climbing to a robot helping to keep the bike weight low.




And who can forget my two most famous inventions?
